Preventative Maintenance Thoughts For You

Don't run out of fuel: It has been our experience that on average, 70% of new customer issues stem from poor fuel management. We recommend you keep a minimum of 20" of oil in your tank at all times. *Diligently keep contaminants out of your supply.*

Air Compressor: Always leave your air compressor running overnight.

Avoid Frozen Air Lines: If you do not have operating compressor air, your Clean Burn furnace will not operate. There are two things you can do to prevent water in your air lines.

Install air dryers on your air compressor system and make sure the air dryers are operating.

OR

Install an automatic water eliminator at the air compressor.

Have you experienced this? *Black smoke, weak spark, doesn't want to burn properly, or unit keeps shutting itself down.*

Hints like that can help us identify that you have contaminants in your waste oil supply tank.

The contaminants could be water, antifreeze, sludge and "new" motor oil. You may need to hire a waste oil hauler to remove them from your waste oil supply

Section 179 Deduction allows a business to deduct the FULL PURCHASE PRICE from your gross income this year!

This deduction enables small businesses to deduct up to \$500,000 of the cost of machinery and equipment, oil and gas storage tanks, and more, placed in service during 2014.
