JANUARY 2014

COLD weather is here. Please find below a couple of tips that can help keep your Clean Burn running properly during this cold snap.

1. Monitor the oil supply in your tank. Make sure you have sufficient good oil. With this extremely cold weather, you will use oil at a much faster rate. Make sure there is plenty of oil in the tank to last over night. **Make sure your oil is not contaminated with antifreeze, water or sludge.**

Approved oils: Crank case oil, Transmission Fluid, New Fuel Oil # 2, #4, and #5, Synthetic Used oil, Hydraulic Fluid (up to 90 Weight), Diesel Oil and Diesel Fuel (New or Used)

2. Make sure your air compressor is in a warm environment. Make sure there is no water in your air compressor or the air compressor line. Water in the air compressor could freeze and cause your air compressor not to work. Your furnace will not operate without air coming from your air compressor.
